

## **CALL FOR ENTRY**

### **CENTRAL COAST ARTISTS COLLECTIVE PRESENTS: SCULPTURE**

**May 18-June 26, 2023**

**Art Center Morro Bay**

**Deadline: March 31, 2023**

**Reception: May 21, 2023, 2-4 pm**

A juried exhibition of work by the Central Coast Artists Collective's Sculptors takes place at Art Center Morro Bay in the Russell Gallery and Main Gallery. There is no theme for the exhibition, and members are encouraged to submit their best and most recent work.

**ELIGIBILITY:** Entry is open to members of Central Coast Sculptors of the Central Coast Artists Collective (CCAC) with valid memberships for 2023. (For information on joining Central Coast Sculptors, visit the [CCAC website](#)).

Please note that shipping is not allowed, and selected artwork must be hand delivered to Art Center Morro Bay on May 16, 2023.

**ENTRY AND FEES:** A maximum of three artworks can be submitted. The entry fee is \$15 whether you enter 1, 2, or 3 pieces. Fees are non-refundable.

Entry is through [EntryThingy](#). Follow that link to login/register, and click on Apply Now next to Central Coast Artists Collective Presents-Sculptors.

The deadline to apply is midnight on **March 31, 2023**. Notification is on or before April 30, 2023.

**SALES:** The Morro Bay Art Association will retain a 25 percent commission on all art sales. The artist receives 75 percent of the sale. All art work must be for sale. Prices set by the artist may not be changed after acceptance.

**JUROR: TRICIA REICHERT**, originally from the UK, is a distinguished local artist, author and art teacher. She paints and teaches in a large variety of mediums including drawing, pastel, watercolor, oil, acrylic, gouache, printmaking and figurative clay sculpture. Tricia specializes in the art of portraiture in both two and three dimensions. Her work is collected internationally and she currently teaches classes in her Arroyo Grande studio and online.

The Juror reserves the right to reject at time of installation any art work that does not meet the standards shown in the images supplied. Art work must be original. Works may not be substituted after jurying.

Submission of work to this exhibition constitutes an agreement to the conditions stated in the Call For Entry and a commitment to show accepted work for the duration of the exhibition. By entering this exhibition, artists agree to allow CCAC and Art Center Morro Bay to use submitted images in promotional material.

## **REQUIREMENTS:**

**SCULPTURE:** Pedestals must be supplied or arranged for beforehand. Wall-hung works will be accepted. All sculptures must be less than 7 feet tall, and have one dimension less than 30". Wall mounted pieces must weigh less than 20 pounds.

Most of the sculptures will be installed in the Russell Gallery which is on the second floor of the Art Center. The stairway is 30" wide. If your piece is heavy, please plan on bringing help at TakeIn. Art Center personnel will not be available to help.

**AWARDS:** Three awards cash awards will be presented. First-\$300, Second-\$200, and Third-\$100.

**LIABILITY DISCLAIMER:** CCAC, its members, and Art Center Morro Bay representatives will make every reasonable effort to protect art from the time it is received until it is returned to the artist. They will not be held responsible for any damage or theft of work. Artists are encouraged to carry their own insurance.

[Central Coast Sculptors](#) is open to all artists ranging from emerging to professional. CCS's goal is to further sculpture on the Central Coast by supporting artists and exhibitions of their work.
