

## THURSDAY PAINTERS: May & June 2022

May 5-**Botanical Gardens**, SLO, 3450 Dairy Creek Road, drive north of SLO on Highway 1- opposite Cuesta College at the light turn right on to Dairy Creek Road. There is a \$5 per person entrance fee.

May 12-**Coleman Park at the end of the Morro Bay Embarcadero**, drive out on Highway 1 to Morro Bay. Take exit street at stop sign turn right on Main St. Right again on Beach Street and right on Embarcadero. Drive beyond harbor where you will see Coleman Park on left. Great views of Morro Rock and harbor waters.

May 19- **Back Bay Inn- Baywood Park**. From SLO, go west on Los Osos Valley Rd. Turn right onto South Bay Blvd. turn left onto Santa Ysabel and turn left on Second St. and go to bay. Park at the Back Bay Inn parking lot or turn west on Santa Maria and left into parking area – this is on the other side of the Inn and out of the way of their guests. Views of the bay and the gardens which are SPECTACULAR! They grow every kind of bulb, tulips, daffodils.

May 26- **T-Pier - Morro Bay**, 1185 Embarcadero, Morro Bay. From SLO drive north on Hwy 1 to Main St. (exit #279A). At stop sign turn right on Main St. Right on Beach Street to end. Right on Embarcadero. The T-Pier is a working pier located near parking lots and public restroom. The Great American Fish Company Restaurant is at the foot of the pier and others are nearby. There is a Fish Market behind Dockside Cafe. Boats, harbor, Morro Rock, water views. We might get lucky and see otters near the pier.

June 2-**Hollister Peak**, Morro Bay, from SLO drive north on highway 1 and turn left across the highway on to Canet Road. Plenty of places to park off this country road with close up views of Hollister.

### June 9- **Port San Luis – Avila Beach**

From SLO drive south on Hwy 101 and exit at San Luis Bay Dr (exit #196). Continue on to the stop light and turn right on Avila Beach Dr. Drive all the way out to the pier. Lots of boats in dry-dock and fishing vessels to paint.

June 16- **Montana de Oro, Spooners Cove**, 3550 Pecho Valley Rd., Los Osos. From SLO go west on Los Osos Valley Road towards Los Osos. Continue through Los Osos and Los Osos Valley Road becomes Pecho Rd when it turns to the left. Continue on Pecho to Spooners Cove. Go to the right and park at the beach below the ranch house or at any of the sites on the cove or up on the bluff.

June 23- **Dinosaur Caves and cliffs**, Shell Beach. Drive south on 101 to Price St Exit, make an immediate right turn on to Price St. Take the first left on Cliff Ave. Views of cliffs, dinosaur rocks and ocean. Spectacular!

June 30- **Leffingwell Landing**, Cambria. Take highway 1 north to Cambria. Make a lefthand turn onto Moonstone Beach Drive (not the first left which is a light but beyond to the next) and an almost immediate right into the Leffingwell Landing Park.
